The Board reviewed a proposal to redesign the De Cou Run Stream Restoration Project and revise the project budget.

Motion: It was moved by John Rigolizzo, seconded by Lori Volpe and passed unanimously to approve the redesign and revised budget for the De Cou Run Stream Restoration Project.

Robert Dobbs informed the Board that the District exhibited the Soil Tunnel for over 400 elementary school children on April 29, 2010 at the Camden Children's Garden [adjacent to Adventure Aquarium]. Karen Mullen and Chasity Williams distributed education materials and guided students through the Soil Tunnel.

Robert Dobbs reported that the New Jersey Envirothon was held Saturday, May 8, 2010 at Camp Sacajawea in Newfield, NJ. 48 high school teams competed in the competition. The student team from Marine Academy of Technology and Environmental Science won first place in the 2010 NJ Envirothon. The team will go on to compete in the National Envirothon.

NEW BUSINESS:

Robert Dobbs and Lori Volpe are continuing to draft the FY2011 Budget. Additional input is required from the State Health Benefits Program and Workers Compensation Insurance. The budget will be addressed during the June District Board Meeting.
