Cooper River Stormwater Basins

- Three Water Quality samples have been completed. We hope to pick up one final sample before the end of October
- Additional planting at Wilderness Run will complete the construction work on this project.
- Final reports, deliverables will be prepared to complete administrative tasks.
- A budget modification has been submitted anticipating the final expenses

DeCou Run Stream Restoration

No changes from last month.

Mantua Implementation Project

- A no cost time extension for this project has been submitted allowing work to continue to mid summer 2012.
- A new group of clinic students from Rowan University are working on this project
- A dormant season planting is being scheduled for the Twin Ponds basin
- Gloucester County continues to drag their feet on an aeration system for Bethel Mill Pond

Cooper River Stormwater Education

- Completed construction at the Cherry Hill Fire Administration rain garden. It looks great.
- The first of two rain gardens at Subaru has been completed. Subaru is planning a dedication ceremony, publicity programs and education opportunities for their employees
- There are several additional rain gardens proposed for this fall
- Project work is currently scheduled to be completed by mid-December

Awaiting final payment from DVRPC – final invoice is \$4578.00

Cooper River Implementation Projects

• We've received the executed grant agreement for this new project and will commence work this fall. This grant totals \$400,000 and includes over \$180,000 in district salary and expenses. The project includes funds for roadside rain gardens, basin renovation, gully repair and pond rehabilitation.
